To perform civil engineering work related to designing, planning, reviewing, and inspecting District facilities and private facilities; performs technical and feasibility studies and makes recommendations based on the results.

Position Qualifications:

- Undergraduate degree in civil engineering or related engineering field from an Accreditation Board for Engineering Technology (ABET) accredited college or university
- Engineer-in-Training (EIT) Certificate required
- Professional Engineer License preferred
- Minimum four (4) years' experience in civil engineering practice or closely related engineering field
- All positions within the District require a valid Washington State driver license with insurable MVR (Motor Vehicle Record), successful completion of pre-employment drug test and extensive background investigation
- Must perform night and weekend duty during the water season (approx. mid-March to mid-October)
- Must live within the District boundaries (approx. north to south, Beezley Hills to Hwy 26; east to west, Soap Lake WA to the Columbia River)

Desired Knowledge, Skills & Abilities:

- Ability to utilize surveying equipment, generate plans, charts, and graphs using computer aided design software (AutoCAD), graphical information system (GIS/ArcInfo), and Microsoft Office
- Possess the knowledge and ability to create, interpret and communicate engineering plans and specifications of hydraulic principles and practices, particularly with regard to open channel, pipe flow, drainage, and pumping systems
- Working knowledge of public works construction
- Basic knowledge of mechanical and electrical fundamentals related to pumps, motors & valves
- Ability to read and write legal descriptions for District right of way, landowner property, and landowner land classification worksheets
- Must be able to obtain US Bureau of Reclamation SCADA clearance
- Self-motivated; able to start and complete projects and tasks with minimal supervision
- Excellent interpersonal and effective communications skills (both oral and written)
- Basic computer skills and working knowledge of Microsoft Office (Word, Excel and Outlook)
